

Autonomous Vehicle Industry Memo AVIM 2022-02

Removing Drivers and Vehicles from Permit

Effective: Immediately

Important Details

To remove an autonomous vehicle and/or autonomous vehicle test driver from an Autonomous Vehicle Testing (AVT) Program Manufacturer Permit, please submit a modification using DMV's online portal <u>Autonomous Vehicle</u> <u>Testing - California DMV</u> and provide the following:

Vehicles

- A Statement of Facts (REG 256) identifying the autonomous vehicles(s) to be removed from the AVT Program Manufacturer Permit. The Statement of Facts shall include how the removal of the vehicle(s) complies with Title 13, Division 1 Chapter 1, and Article 3.7 Section 227.54.
- If transferring the autonomous vehicle(s), a copy of the Notice(s) of Release of Liability (NRL).
- If dismantling the autonomous vehicle(s), a copy of the non-repairable certification(s).

Drivers

- A Statement of Facts (REG 256) identifying the driver(s) to be removed from the AVT Program Manufacturer Permit and certifying INF Form 1100 has been submitted to the EPN Unit.
- A copy of the Commercial Employer Pull Notice (EPN) Enrollment or Deletion Form (INF 1100), indicating the deletion of the driver(s) from the EPN program.

Note: If you have lost or are unable to locate the OL 313 and/or OL 314 please indicate this information on the REG 256 Statement of Facts.
