### 2022 Miscellaneous Fee Increases

#### New Information

Effective January 1, 2022, two Occupational Licensing-related fees will increase. These fees will affect occupational licensees with identification (ID) license plates, such as dealers, manufacturers, dismantlers, distributors, remanufacturers, and vehicle transporters.

#### Procedures

Programming will be in place to calculate the following fee increases:

Several fees authorized by the *Vehicle Code* are subject to an annual adjustment based upon the Consumer Price Index.
