

Notice of Modification of Proposed Regulations

Title 13, Division 1, Chapter 1

Article 3.0 – Driver Licenses and Identification Cards

Section 156.00, 156.01, 156.02 – Clean Air Vehicle Decals

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.8(c), the Department of Motor Vehicles (department) provides this notice for the purpose of inviting comments regarding modification of the proposed regulations governing the gender categories on driver's licenses and identification cards. The regulatory language as originally proposed was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on February 9, 2024.

Attached is the full text of the proposed regulation. The text includes the originally proposed language as well as the proposed changes to the language. The language modifications are clearly illustrated by the following methods:

- (1) The language originally proposed to be added to the text is single underlined.
- (2) The language originally proposed to be repealed from the text is ~~overstruck~~.
- (3) The language now proposed to be repealed which was originally proposed to be added is ~~overstruck and single underlined~~.
- (4) The language now proposed to be added is double underlined.
- (5) The language now proposed to be repealed is ~~double overstruck~~.
